

‘Read Me a Book’
Student Volunteering Program
National Library for Children and Young Adults

The National Library for Children and Young Adults is running the ‘Read Me a Book’ Student Volunteering Program to support children’s reading activities and to provide volunteering opportunities for undergraduate/graduate students. The volunteering is open to all undergraduate/graduate students who are interested and capable of volunteering for the ‘Read Me a Book’ program.

Summary

- **Qualification:** Undergraduate/graduate students of ages 18 and over
 - * *Preference will be given to students majoring in library and information science, early childhood education, and foreign languages and Korean-speaking foreign students*
- **Volunteering schedule:** (1) During semesters: On weekends
(2) During school holidays: From Tuesday to Sunday
- **Volunteering time:**
 - Choose from (1) Morning session (10:00-16:00)
(2) Afternoon session (14:00-18:00)
 - * *The volunteers are required to keep the starting time of each session as specified.*
 - Volunteering hours should be 2 hours at the least and 5 hours at the most.
 - * *Lunch hour (1 hour) is not included in morning session volunteering hours, while in the case of afternoon session, no more than 4 hours of volunteering hours can be performed.*
 - Work description
 - Read 2-3 books to children while wearing the Yellow Apron in the Picture Book World or the Storytelling Room. (The books can be selected from the *List of Recommended Books by Librarians, Multicultural Collection*, etc.)
 - After reading to a group of children, perform a one-to-one reading with a child.
 - After the one-to-one reading, do reading activities with the child such as sharing thoughts, drawing together, coloring, paper craft, and so on.
 - Put the books on the shelves and organize the reading room.
 - For those who are bilingual/multilingual speakers, assistance in exhibiting multicultural collections can be requested.
